

Community Involvement Plan Update

Contractor CH2MHILL has been retained by National Guard Bureau to conduct long-term monitoring (LTM) for Installation Restoration Program (IRP) Site 4 (Former Underground Fuel Tank) at the 139th Airlift Wing, Missouri ANG, Rosecrans Memorial Airport, St. Joseph, Missouri.

In 2006, remedies for Site 4 were developed after completion of the field study. The field activities for site cleanup included excavation of the contaminated soils and treatment with a chemical oxidation agent, removal of the existing 500-gallon tank, and groundwater treatment by injection of an oxidizing reagent. Groundwater monitoring wells were installed and sampled over more than two years. Soil and groundwater concentrations are below Missouri action levels for further cleanup. The ANG submitted a request for No Further Action to MDNR in December 2012. MDNR has requested additional sampling in FY2015.

Currently, contractor CH2MHILL will begin quarterly sampling in FY2015 of a few monitoring wells on 139th Airlift Wing federal property until late FY2017.
