



## General Information

### ***Purpose***

Since 1983, the Advanced Airlift Tactics Training Center has hosted the Tactics & Intelligence Symposium to promote finding solutions to current tactical challenges by providing participants the opportunity to learn from subject matter experts and vendors, as well as to network with over 300 fellow mobility professionals.

### ***Theme***

This year' theme is "Information Overload—Tactics in the Digital Age." The symposium will focus on datalink, sensor fusion and automation with an emphasis on how these systems can and should provide increased situational awareness while reducing aircrew workload. We will discuss emerging threats and improving operator/intelligence integration in planning and execution.

### ***Classification***

All classified briefings at this year's event will be at the secret level releasable to US, AUS, CAN, GBR, NZL (FIVE EYES) and will only be available to personnel with verified security clearances.

### ***Participation***

Historically, what began as an annual C-130 tactics event has grown to include significant participation from the entire community of mobility operations and intelligence professionals. Recent military attendance has shown a notable increase from the C-5, C-17, C-20, C-21, C-27, C-40, KC-10, and KC-135 communities.



## General Information

### ***Fees***

The attendee fee for the Symposium is \$40. Ten dollars (\$10) is a “landing fee” for conference participation costs and thirty dollars (\$30) covers the cost of the Symposium Banquet.

### ***Location***

UNCLASSIFIED presentations will be held at the **Holiday Inn Theatre** all day Monday and on Tuesday evening. All CLASSIFIED presentations will be held on Rosecrans ANGB in the **Rausin Auditorium** on the **second floor of Building 51** (139 AW HQ) and **Breakout Groups**. Refer to the map on **page 16** for building locations and see the briefing agenda on **page 19** for briefing start times.

### ***Base Parking***

A base parking pass will be provided for entry onto the base. Please ensure it is prominently displayed while you are on base. Follow the signs to the designated Symposium parking areas east and southwest of Building 51. See base map on **page 18**. Parking space is limited—carpooling and early arrivals are highly recommended.

### ***AATTC Symposium Conference Control Center***

The Conference Control Center is located in Building 51, across the hall from the break area. It will be manned Tuesday-Thursday. Late registration, Commercial and DSN phone lines, and administrative services are available. ID badge replacement is also available.

### ***Break Area***

Tuesday through Thursday, a break area will be located on the 1st floor of Building 51. **Snacks, beverages and coffee will be provided.**

### ***Smoking Area***

Smoking is permitted in designated areas only. **The smoking areas are located outside of the north and south entrances at the most eastern edge of the building.** Smoking is not permitted outside the west (flight line side) entrance or within fifty feet of a building entrance.

### ***Ground Transportation***

A shuttle service will be available for transportation between the Holiday Inn, Stoney Creek, and other hotels during the evening vendor display socials and Symposium Banquet on Wednesday night. Refer to the shuttle schedule on **page 28**.

### **Uniform**

The military uniform of the day (UOD) for the briefings during the week is FDU (flight suit), ABU or equivalent. Business casual for civilians is appropriate. **Dress for the Symposium Banquet is casual.**



## To Rosecrans ANGB






