## 1. The Missouri Military Family Relief Fund (MMFRF)

### ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Be a National Guard or a Reserve member that either lives in or drills for Missouri.
- Hold a rank from E-1 up to O-3 or W-2.
- Have not received a previous grant from this fund within the last 12 months
- Not have a situation that requires a monetary resolution in less than a week

### NOT COVERED

- Nonessentials (cell, cable, Wi-Fi, etc.)
- To finance leave or vacations
- Pay fines or legal expenses
- Help liquidate or consolidate debt
- Cover bad checks or pay credit card bills
